








## Overall Participation




## Indonesia Participation



## France Participation




# THEMATICS: NUSANTARA FEEDBACK



- 59 eligible proposal (with 70 initially opened applications)
- In line with FR and ID priorities
- Engineering (25%), AgroForestry (20%), Health (15%), TIC (15%), SHS (10%)

- Agronomy, animal, vegetal and agroalimentary products
- Engineer science
- Biology, health, medecine
- Maths and interactions
- Information and communication science and technology
- Human science and humanities



# TREND OVER TIME THROUGH NUSANTARA DATA


Thematic fields evolution

Impact of the thematics on the number of PhD


- 63 PhD Students defending PhD degree or registered in PhD curricula (About 20% in Social and Human Sciences)



- About 85% of Indonesian publications are co-authored with international partners (about 55% for France)
- Around 5 % of Indonesian publications are authored jointly with France : rate is stable over last 5 years (Half thanks to CNRS institution)
- But less than 0.1% of French publications are authored jointly with Indonesia




# EXISTING FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

Over 82 identified schemes for funding in order to strengthen FR-ID cooperation in Research:



- Environment: 15 CFP
- Health: 10 CFP
- Humanities: 9 CFP
- Fundamental Sciences: 4 CFP
- Energy: 4 CFP
- Agroforestry: 3 CFP
- Engineering : 3 CFP

With time length over 2 years: 19



- Pretty large funding availabilities and spectra
- Clear Priority for funders in Environment, Health and Humanities
- Need for pushing more long-term CFP

# CONCLUSIONS

- « Instant vision » of key players & theatics with quantification of present activity
- Need to identify a way for getting consolidated data (ID partners and FR ones)
- After:
  - Possibility to identify how the different schemes of cooperation can support the main theatics,
  - Can achieve visible impact, can structure the players,
  - Help to identify a clear network of actors by theatics
